




Vendor & Artist Information

The Geek Mania event will be at the Angel Centre, Angel Lane, Tonbridge, Kent, TN9 1SF. The venue is open to the public from 10:00 until 16:30.

Access for Vendors & Artists will be from 08:30 and everyone should be clear of the hall by 18:00.

Access to the hall within the venue can be made via the side fire door exit, which can be found along the side alleyway of the centre, as shown on the photo below:



The side alleyway is narrow with only room for 1 vehicle; Geek Mania volunteers will be available to coordinate vehicles into this alley way. If you can make do without vehicle access you can use Sainsbury Trolleys to move your gear into the hall, we just ask that the trolleys are returned sensibly and safely.

Once your Get-In is completed you have various parking options in Tonbridge. Two options that we can suggest are as follows (*details and map of locations*):

- A) Sovereign Way Mid – Long stay Pay & Display car park
- B) Tonbridge Station Car Park B

PLEASE NOTE: All car parks in Tonbridge charge on Sunday's, so please ensure that you pay for the time your vehicle is parked to avoid receiving a fine. Geek Mania takes no responsibility for any parking charges you may incur.

Penalty Charges of £50 & £70 apply
Contravention examples

1. Failing to display a valid ticket or permit in windscreen or to pay by phone

5. Parking anywhere that is not clearly designated as a parking bay
6. Parking in a disabled parking bay without correctly displaying a valid Blue Badge

 - Failure to correctly enter your vehicle registration number when prompted at the pay machine or online.
 - Overtaying the parking period paid for.
 - Failure to park within a marked parking bay or causing an obstruction to other users.
 - Parking in a Blue Badge Bay without being registered on APCOA Blue Badge portal - <https://bluebadge.apcoa.co.uk>


Charges for breach of these parking conditions:
£60 (if paid within 14 days)
£100 (if paid later than 14 days)
Cash/credit card for method of payment

The operator reserves the right to take legal action for a higher amount to recover any losses and may apply to the DVLA for keeper details to pursue outstanding debts if this Charge remains unpaid after 28 days, or is not cancelled on appeal. Hall Layout & Set Up:

On your arrival you will be informed of your table number/location within the hall, please unload as quickly as possible if using the side alley way to allow others to use it. Set up of your area should be completed by 09:45.

If you have any problems or issues on the day, please inform a Geek Mania Volunteer as soon as possible.

We know vending works best with a great team behind the tables, but to keep things fair and comfortable for everyone, we do have limits on how many people can be behind each vendor space:

- 1 table: maximum 2 people
- 2–3 tables: maximum 4 people
- 5+ tables: maximum 6 people

Please note: children count toward your total number.

If these limits are exceeded, we may need to ask additional helpers to leave the vending area, so please plan accordingly and be considerate of your neighbouring vendors.

Each area will be provided with a bin bag, and we kindly ask that you keep your area clean and tidy during the event.

If you have children with you during set up or pack down, please be aware they are your responsibility and we ask you to keep them with you at all times and that they do not interfere with other vendors.

All attendees will be required to wear a wristband, any attendee without a wristband will be asked to leave.

Refreshments On Site:

During the event within the hall, we will have a stall that will be selling coffees, cold drinks and snacks, there will also be a sweet treats stall and a doughnut stall. At this point we can't confirm but we are also hoping to have a pizza van just outside the front entrance of the Angel Centre.
